

Montgomery County House Delegation Officially Gains New Member; David Fraser-Hidalgo Sworn In

ANNAPOLIS, MD, October 21, 2013 -- David Fraser-Hidalgo was sworn in today to the Maryland House of Delegates by Speaker Michael Busch and is now officially a Maryland Delegate and a member of the Montgomery County House Delegation, representing Maryland Legislative District 15. Delegate Fraser-Hidalgo was selected by the Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee and recommended to Governor O'Malley for appointment to the seat vacated by Brian Feldman. Feldman, after serving 11 years in the House, was appointed last month to the District 15 Senate seat recently vacated by Senator Rob Garagiola.
