4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to  
5 enter a certain building or premises at certain times to post a certain notice on  
6 the entry door of the building or premises under certain circumstances; and  
7 generally relating to customer notices of the Washington Suburban Sanitary

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1           **THE COMMISSION MAY ENTER A BUILDING OR PREMISES THAT HAS A**  
2 **CONNECTION WITH THE WATER SUPPLY OR SEWER SYSTEM UNDER THE**  
3 **JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION AT A REASONABLE TIME TO POST A NOTICE**  
4 **ON THE ENTRY DOOR OF THE BUILDING OR PREMISES THAT INFORMS**  
5 **CUSTOMERS OF PROJECT INFORMATION AND CONSTRUCTION-RELATED EVENTS**  
6 **THAT ARE BEING PROPOSED OR IMPLEMENTED, INCLUDING TEMPORARY**  
7 **SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS AND CONSTRUCTION START-UP DATES.**

8           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2010.
